Administrative Addendum

- 2000 Conference Chair for 22nd *American Holistic Medical Association Annual Conference, (AHMA)*. Created new policies that are currently adopted by AHMA for all conferences. Total profit from this meeting was \$63,000. This was twice the previous record for profit and over three times the previous average for these meetings.
- 1998—1999 Medical Consultant for *Wild Oats Foundation Wellness Centers*. Recruited by the owner of this large natural food company to develop and oversee rollout of Wellness Centers in major cities of Western United States. Participated in the opening of three initial centers (Boulder, Denver, and Albuquerque). Project cancelled due to corporate financial woes.
- 1997—1999 Founded *Inner-Health Clinic of Fort Collins*. This integrative clinic of 13 practitioners and 7 physicians opened its doors in December of 1998 and has continued to experience a 30-40% growth per year. I was elected the initial CEO and administered the entire clinic for two years. I sold my share to the two family practice physicians.
- 1997—2005 *McKee Center for Holistic Medicine*, McKee Medical Center—Banner Health System. Loveland, CO. Initiated complementary medicine development. Provided corporate-wide consultation to this 23,000-employee hospital system. Designed and implemented *Center for Holistic Medicine*, dealing with significant medical staff and administrative issues. Opened May 2001.
- 1992—1996 Founded *Pathways* in Greeley, Colorado. This multidisciplinary mental health group grew from my solo practice to 12 providers and a \$1.2 million budget within four years. I sold this practice to two psychiatrists whom I recruited prior to my 1996 sabbatical in Australia.
- 1991—2005 *Youth Passages*, Greeley, Colorado. Designed an innovative adolescent day treatment program. This program successfully integrated local school district and county department of social services involvement. Recently, this program effectively expanded in the face of brutal cuts by managed care. Average census: 12-15 teens.
